Definitions	
a material that changes the color of reflected or transmitted light

periodic motion of a rigid or elastic body or medium forced from a position or state of equilibrium	
invisible radiant energy	
when struck by light of certain wavelengths, as by ultraviolet	
the outside part or uppermost layer of something	
the millionth part of a meter	
a substance that cannot be separated into simpler substances by chemical means	
a soft, deep blue copper mineral produced by weathering of copper ore deposits	
a naturally occurring chemical compound
